GRD.591 - Honor Roll

(Can download to - Build File Option) (Can be used also for Work Ethic Lists)

- Order of Grade Titles is important. Unless Cum GPA='Y', the first non-blank value will be used in calculation.

Pre-requisites

- GRD.250 (Grade Symbols) - Mean everything in calculation
- SCH.310 (Crse Credit) - Mean everything in calculation

Build File option 'Y' : Report will not be generated. Instead a PC file will be created on the AS/400 that can be downloaded to Excel or Word

Can exclude selected Grade Symbols values (eg: Failures), or Work Ethic values

Sample Calculation:

- Always print the report in detail and random check students to ensure all appropriate courses and/or values are being included
- Report can be run for Feeder School's. Sort alpha, select Last School Attended
- Honor roll tags can be generated and included on report cards and/or transcript print. NOTE: Do not auto-update/fill-in tag info until FINAL runs, ie: do not build tag until you know report is validated and accurate.
- Use Work Ethic values and limit to valid number of credits to produce ethic qualifications
- **All Honor Roll Levels (Principal, B Honor, Ethic ...) should be pre-defined in GRD.291. It is WAY to easy to miss-key information when you are running/re-running honor roll listings. By having the formats pre-defined you will ensure that they are run consistently each time!**

GRD.558 - Print Students with Specific Marks (Failing, Perfect, Missing) (Failures, Incompletes, All marks over 97%, etc)

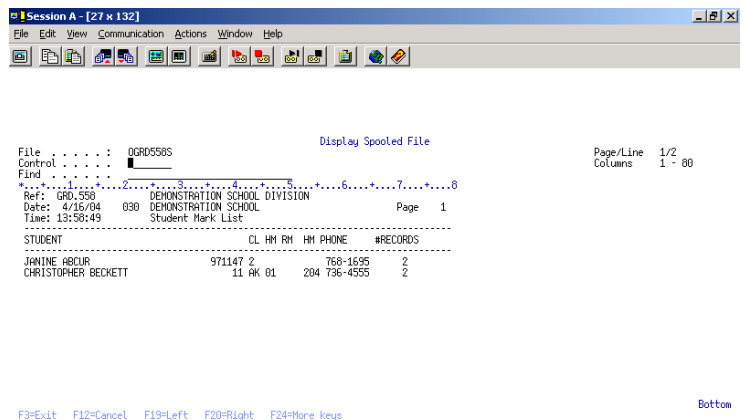
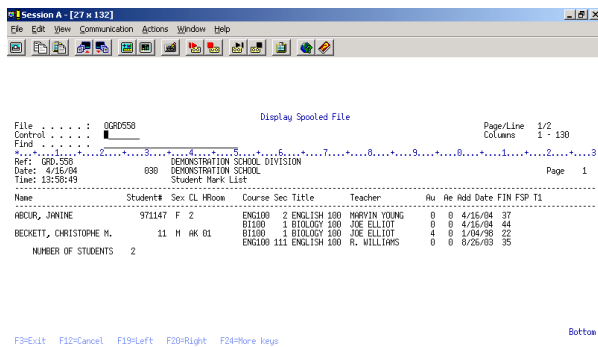
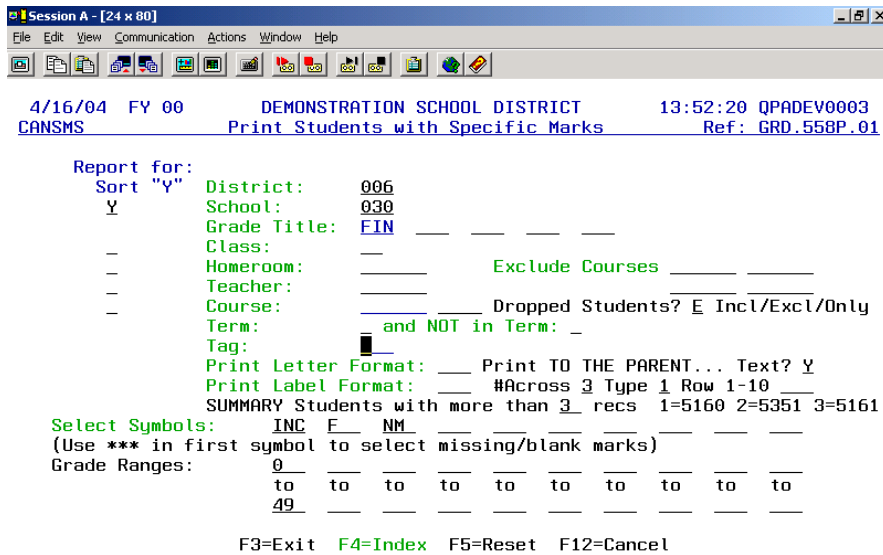

- Look for 1st Semester Failing final marks (Term 1 and not in 3 - example above)
- Look for high achievers
- Create a letter/merge for all students with failures
- Sort by Teacher or course or student
- **Limit report to symbols (A,F,INC) and/or grade range values (0-49)**
- Report shows course & teacher information PLUS student absences and potentially phone#

GRD.558 – Hit List Report for students with Multiple Failures

GRD.558 can print both phone number and absence information. Fields are available to include only students with say MORE THAN X failures. Lists like this can assist in alerting administration to achievement concerns – hopefully caught in the earlier progress reporting so that they might get resolved in time to correct.

- Select to Sort by Student
- Identify how many failures you are looking for
- Choose to include phone numbers

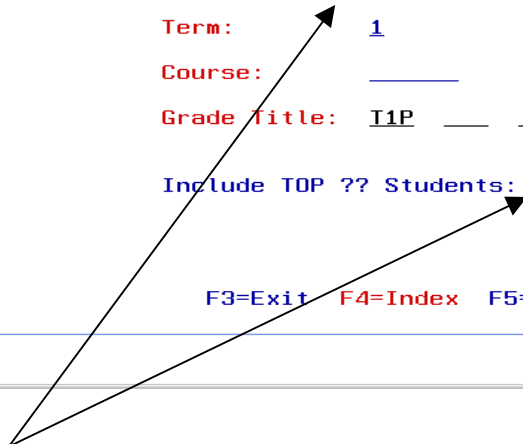

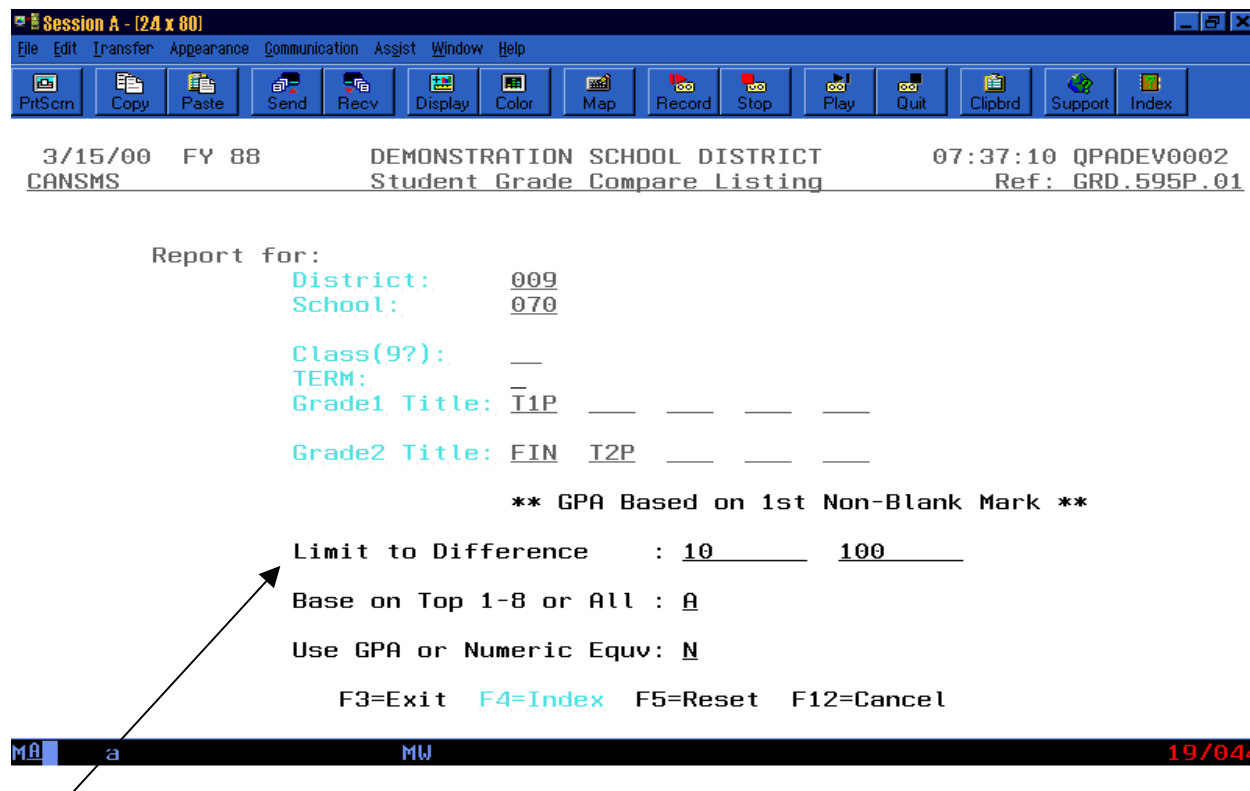

GRD.595 - Grade Compare Listing

(Indicate students whose marks are significantly different from term to term)
(ie: Look for both most improved, and most unimproved (needs attention))

- a) Run the report first looking for positive differences (ie: most improved)
- b) Run the report again to look for negative differences (-10 to -100)



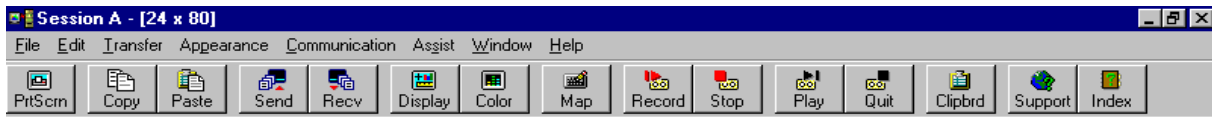
Indicates that report will identify any students whose marks for Final or 2nd progress is more than 10% different than the first term

GRD.590 - Grade Matrix - Best by Homeroom or Grade Level (Good for Admin Reviews, Homeroom Statistics)

Use this report for admin meetings & situations where you want to get a visual on each student and subject area for a single term or several term marks.

Make sure to setup format(s) first to make the job of executing the report easy (GRD.292)

Each column can include multiple courses, eg: EN 11, or LIT 11, or COMM 11 all pertain to English so may be grouped into a single column for kid comparison.

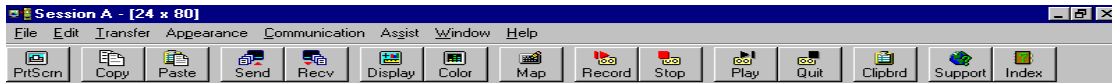

Ideal report for analyzing how students are achieving per course/section and also see drops, absences and course average values. This report may be downloaded to a file and manipulated in Excel as shown below.

Report can be run for selected Tag(s) of students, by grade level, and or by sex.

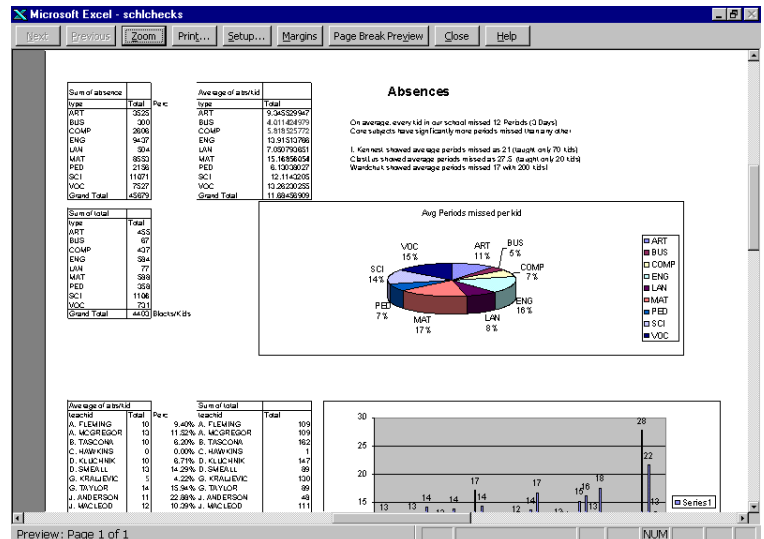
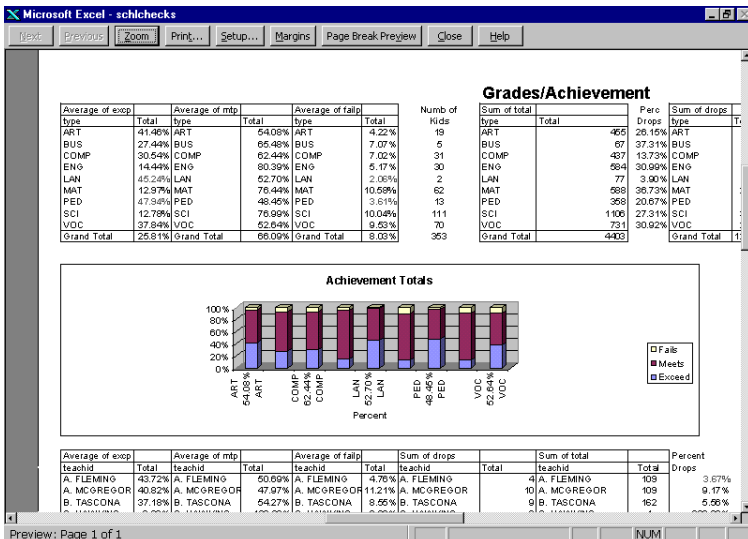

Statistical Grade Reporting - GRD.894

GRD.555 produces statistics based on each individual course. GRD.894 groups courses by their mandatory course group and reports to the group level, eg: how are grade 9 students doing in Math (includes all calculus, math, business courses etc. marked with MATH category)

- Select Male/Female
- Select Students by Tag (eg: First Nations)
- Select Grade Titles

Report produces by course type (eg: ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCES) Number and percentage of students that Exceed, Meet, Fail to meet expectations defined by user when running the report

If you are relying on this report for annual school growth reporting, make sure to qualify the numbers, ie: do the number of students look reasonable in comparison to your grade level totals?

- Can run based on Transcript information OR based on current report card grades
- Can subtotal by grade level
- Can run for Last Year Feeder school for global perspective to provide to Elementary Feeders on how their students are achieving at next school level

GRD.570 – Scholarship/Cumulative Credit Check for Grade 12's

This report combines student current grades (those selected by user eg: Term 3 Progress), Semester 1 Finals (any current course with a final not yet transcribed)– and ALL transcript history to identify for selected students a cumulative GPA and total credits completed and current.

This has only been available since April 2003. This is a CRITICAL report that all high schools should be using. It considers TRAX in BC.

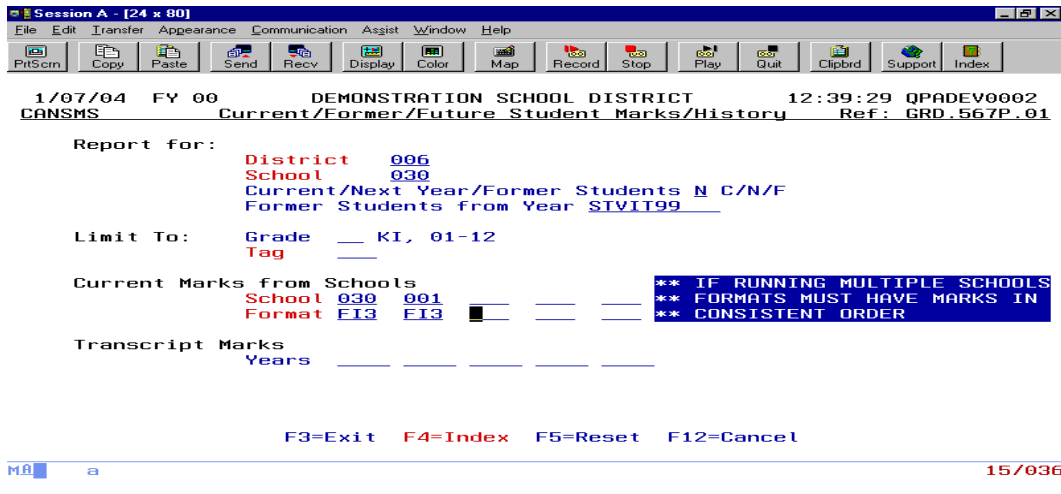
Keep in Mind that this report considers transcript and current courses for the student at the school. If a student has completed courses at other schools (and not transcribed) then make sure to followup with report SCH.711 to identify what students are taking courses elsewhere - then use SCH.410 and F15 to review the progress of those courses online.

GRD.567 - Current/Former/Future Student Mark Info/History

This program produces a report of all current, former or next year students and their current marks for up to 5 schools and/or transcript/TRAX history for up to 5 years.

The purpose of the report is to allow you to look at:

- Students who are currently yours and what their marks are now compare with previous years (transcript)
- Students who are currently yours and how they are doing currently at other locations (alt schools)
- Students who will be yours say Next Year and how they are doing currently at their home locations
- Students who were yours (former) and how are they doing at their new locations
